



Student Welfare

Our International Student Co-ordinator looks after the welfare of our overseas students. Students are given an orientation tour of Dunedin city, shortly after arrival.



Guidance and Careers teachers provide information on careers, tertiary education, training courses and subject choice. The careers teacher assists students with applications to universities.



Students are buddied with 'kiwi' students in their form class. As well there is a co-ordinator at each form level. Students meet in form classes with a form teacher each day.

Accommodation

The International Homestay Coordinator is responsible for the careful placement of students in New Zealand homes. Payment is made through the school. Students are met at the airport and the home stay coordinator meets with all the students regularly to ensure that they are happy with their home stay family.

Queen's High School is a signatory to the Code of Practice for the Pastoral Care of International Students.



English Language Entry Requirements

Senior students are required to prove proficiency in English before they can undertake their course of study. Students who begin in Year 9 are immersed in ESOL classes if their English language is at beginner level before moving into the mainstream classes.
