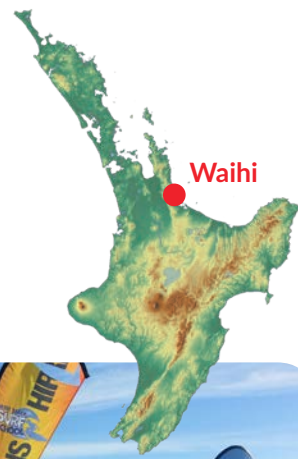


Waihi, Nordinsel
