## TUITION: NZ\$14,500.00

Included in the year's tuition fees are:

- All tuition fees include tuition for English during school hours. For students whose English is very weak an extra fee may be charged for extra classes until the student can operate effectively in classes. This is discussed at enrolment. Textbooks (on loan).
- Orientation programme for International students.
- Bank fees.
- Normal subject fees


## Items not included are:

- Local telephone calls from the homestay are free, but international or national calls and Internet / e-mail charges are a separate charge to the student.
- Outdoor education fees apart from the basic course cost are additional. For specific costs please ask for confirmation of the course costs at the time of enrolment.
- Costs for co-curricular activities such as sport and music which require uniform and/or equipment/gear.
- Field Trips are not included as part of the tuition fee and are an additional cost.
- Examination fees for senior students who may choose to sit external examinations e.g. National Certificate in Educational Achievement [approximately \$400.00]
- Subject fees where materials and equipment are additional requirements e.g. scientific calculator, Art and Design resources.
- Stationery [approximately $\$ \mathbf{1 0 0 . 0 0}$ per year, but dependent on subject choice].

Students who wish to stay over the Christmas vacation will pay extra for homestay.
Students who return home over the Christmas vacation in December/January pay a retaining fee to the Host Family of $\mathbf{\$ 2 0 0 . 0 0}$ for the holiday period. The retaining fee insures their room is kept for them and all their belongings will remain in the room while they are away. Students who go away for more than one week, in the school holidays during the year, are able to apply for a reduction in the fee charged. Notice must be given before the student goes on holiday.

## CONTINGENCY

This is deposited into the students school account to cover costs such as sports fees, field trips, etc. It is $\$ 1000$ for a year, $\$ 600$ for the half year. What is not used is refunded at the end of the student's stay.
